Equipment & Materials List

Exploring the Magic of Stranded Colourwork with Mary Jane Mucklestone

Starts Tues 6th January at 7pm

Students will need:

Six or more colors of fingering weight yarn; 15-20 yards of each color. More colors will allow for more choice and experimentation. Shetland wool is preferred because of the amazing array of colors, and the unique properties that make it ideal for colorwork. Make sure to have 3 light colors and 3 dark colors. Dive into your stash! Bring extra for experimentation.

Students are encouraged to use Shetland wool, but any yarn that comes in array of colors will work. You can use whatever you have in your stash. If you dislike using such fine yarn, it's possible to use thicker yarn for the class, the finished swatches will just be larger.

- Needles to match your yarn. Double pointed needles and a 40cm circular needle
- Stitch markers
- Tapestry needle
- Graph paper
- Colored pencils
- Tape, post-it notes (optional)
