Equipment & Materials List

A Year on the Coast – Season One
Starts Wed 22nd April at 10am

Students will need:

PAPERS

- Medium weight mixed-media or watercolour paper
- Lightweight paper such as photocopy paper or thin cartridge paper
- Small selection of papers for collage such as book pages, maps (especially of coastal areas if you have them), ephemera such as tickets, wrappers, information leaflets (again, if they are relevant to visits to the coast that's great – but not essential).
- Matchboxes of different sizes (or similar small boxes)

PAINTS

- Acrylic paints: Basic Colours: Process Cyan, Process Magenta, Process Yellow, Black, White (I would recommend Daler Rowney System 3) plus any others you may have.
- Oil paint or water-soluble oil paint (such as Winsor & Newton Artisan – or similar): Prussian Blue and Burnt Umber or just Black.

TOOLS

- Brushes – whatever you have – I recommend a flat synthetic, a round synthetic and a fine brush plus an old bristle brush (a kids glue brush will be fine)
- Roller/brayer (not essential, but very useful)
- Mixing palette / plate / tear-off palette – whatever you have.
- Markmaking tools such as: small pieces of cardboard, cotton buds, kitchen sponges, small pieces of cotton rag, etc

MISCELLANEOUS

- Piece of plastic sheet such as acetate or Perspex from a clip frame (approx. A4 size)
- Small plastic food containers
- Glue stick or PVA, masking tape
- Kitchen roll, kitchen sponge, water pots, scissors and/or craft knife, dessert spoon, apron or old shirt (essential – acrylics are waterproof when dry!)

There may be random additional things that we need for particular projects (nothing expensive or difficult to get!) – I will add details of anything extra to the Padlet before the session so you have time to get prepared if you want to work along with me.
