Equipment & Materials List

Botanical Watercolours: Fresh Colours of Spring Starts Tues 14th April at 10am

Students will need:

- Watercolours paints – pans or tubes - in the following colours:
 - Permanent Rose, Cadmium Red, Cadmium Yellow, Lemon Yellow, Ultramarine blue and Cerulean Blue (or Cobalt Blue or Winsor Blue).
 - And perhaps Burnt Sienna and/or Raw Umber and perhaps viridian, though not essential.
- Tracing Paper
- Two or three small sheets of Watercolour Hot Pressed 90lb (190 gsm) or, preferably, 140lb (300gsm) watercolour paper or one bigger piece. This can be Arches, Waterford Hot pressed paper, Fabriano Artistico or Fabriano 5 (Classico) or Bockingford
- HB and 2B pencils and an eraser
- Three good paint brushes. Must have good points! Nos. 7 or 8 round, No. 2 or 3 round, and a small brush Nos: 00 for finer detail
- A couple of “old “brushes for mixing paint
- Kitchen towel
- A small natural sponge (optional but handy)
- Masking fluid and a dip pen or stick with which to apply it
- Notebook
