Equipment & Materials List

A Year on the Coast: Something Fishy!
Wed 23rd September at 10am UK time

Students will need:

- Mediumweight mixed-media or watercolour paper
- Newspaper and scrap paper
- Tracing paper or greaseproof paper
- Optional: Fabric such as calico or cotton
- Acrylic paints: Basic Colours: Process Cyan, Process Magenta, Process Yellow, Black, White (I would recommend Daler Rowney System 3) plus any others you may have.
- Optional: Posca pen or gel pen – gold & white and/or iridescent paints or medium
- Water-soluble pencil in a dark colour (but an ordinary one would be fine)
- Brushes – whatever you have – I recommend a flat synthetic, a round synthetic and a fine brush plus an old bristle brush (a kids glue brush will be fine)
- Mixing palette / plate / tear-off palette – whatever you have.
- Acrylic Matt Medium or PVA glue
- Salt, cotton buds, bubble wrap
- Scissors / craft knife, washing-up-liquid
- Kids craft foam (plus something to back it on – a piece of plastic from a food container or sturdy cardboard)
- Kitchen roll, kitchen sponge, apron or old shirt (essential – acrylics are waterproof when dry!)
