Equipment & Materials List

Twining: Adding Warps & Finding Form Starts Thurs 12th March at 10am

Essential Materials

- Paper Yarn, 2 ply thick (2.5-3mm), minimum one colour, sold in 40m balls. NB. Should NOT have a wire core.
- Paper Yarn, 2 ply thin (1.5-2mm), minimum two colours, minimum length required 100m, sold in a range of lengths 10m+. NB. Should NOT have a wire core.

Optional Materials

- Strings and twines: office string, garden twine, sisal string, hemp twine.
- 'Fancy yarns'; knitting/tapestry wool, cotton, threads etc. NB. Minimum thickness DK yarn.

Essential Equipment

- Scissors, for cutting string
- Scissors, for cutting finer threads
- Tapestry needle (size 16 is good)
- Plastic needle (with large eye)
- Small bulldog clips or clothes pegs (16)
- Masking tape
- 30cm ruler
- Tape measure
- Worksheets printed out

Optional Equipment

- Thimble
- Reading glasses
- Notebook
- Camera/phone for keeping a record
- Luggage labels
- Empty box to become sketchbox (shoe box would be fine). You may already have one from the previous Introduction to Twining course.

Suggested / Preferred Suppliers:

- Etsy – CommunityCraftsUK has both thicknesses, listed as 'paper string'. There are other suppliers on Etsy, but this will give an idea of what is required.
- Fred Aldous – Rico Paper String – 20m ball, 1mm thickness. Pastel colours
- Creativ Company (UK) Ltd – Paper Yarn – 40m ball, 2.5-3mm thickness. Range of colours.



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- John James Needles sell tapestry needles, a selection would be good, and plastic needles.
- LindeHobby UK – Twisted Paper Yarn – 250m, 1mm thickness. Many, many colours!

Pre-Class Preparation

Class 3A

- Pre-cut 8x15cm in thick paper yarn. Works bundled base with 3 rounds of pairs, 3 rounds of singles.

Class 3B

- Cut 16x30cm in thick paper yarn. Using either a cross-over base 8x8 (square) or a square patterned base (8x8) start a pod. Work 3 rounds in pairs and 3 rounds single.
