Equipment & Materials List

Hand-Stitched Vases & Vessels

Starts Mon 16th March at 2pm UK time

Students will need:

- Paper (printer/copier paper is suitable)
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Something with a 90 degree angle to help create a squared edge, this could be a set square, quilters' ruler or, simply, a book to draw around
- Assorted remnants of fabric - cotton and linen are ideal as is lightweight denim (anything heavier will require sturdier needles to work thread through)
- Thread - sewing thread to tack and piece fabrics, embroidery thread (anchor or DMC) for embellishment
- Approximately 2 sheets of A4-sized wadding - this could be quilters' wadding, felt or re-purposed blanket or fleece blanket
- Sewing kit to include: scissors, needles, sewing thread, embroidery thread (optional), pins, quilters clips (useful but optional)
- Two or three jars or tins with straight sides

Suggested / Preferred Suppliers:

- Your local haberdashery shop should be able to supply most of these items, if not, try Hobbycraft
- Look in your wardrobe for old clothes and linens that you can re-purpose or visit your local charity shops or try Vinted
