Carve and Print your own Rubber Stamps

Wed 12th August at 10am UK time

Students will need:

To make rubber stamps

- Rubber for carving. Look for a large flat square or rectangular firm rubber eraser or rubber made specifically for carving rubber stamps. Perhaps purchase one or two until you find a brand you like then buy more. Suggested brands
 - Helix pencil erasers
 - 2 inch square rubber carving blocks from Amazon
 - Speedball brand Speedy Carve for larger pieces
- Lino cutting tools – small detailed cutters are best because we will be working small. Please make sure your cutting tools are sharp
- Small cutting mat
- Awl or bradawl (optional)
- Scalpel or craft knife (optional)
- Pencil
- Tracing paper
- Ink pads. Use what you have but if you need to go shopping, here are some suggested brands:
 - Versa Fine or Versa Fine Clair for printing onto paper
 - Versa Fine Craft for printing onto fabric
 - StayZon – for printing onto non-porous surfaces such as acetate
- Paper and / or fabric to print on
- Scrap paper for testing stamps

For mini book project

- 1 sheet A4 card and 8 sheets of A4 paper
- Awl / bradawl for making holes
- Cutting tools: Cutting mat, craft knife, metal ruler
- Strong thread eg linen thread
- Needle

For stencil project

- Two sheets of A4 or A3 paper
- Scissors
- Masking tape
