Paint Along: Little Collage Landscapes

Wed 29th July at 2pm UK time

Students will need:

- Watercolour paper or Mixed Media paper (approx. 200gsm or heavier)
- Photocopy paper or lightweight cartridge paper and/or wet-strength tissue such as Carnival Papers to make collage papers
- Any book pages, music scores, subtle patterned paper that you may already have in your stash!
Please don't buy any in especially
- Watercolour or Acrylic paints – primary colours plus black and white (and any others you may have). If using watercolour, a tube of white gouache is useful.
- Palette / water pot / brushes – whatever you have including scraggy and bristle brushes if you have them.
- Markmaking tools and materials such as sticks, cotton buds, small pieces of cardboard, textures to make rubbings from, stencils, things to print with such as ribbed card, bubble wrap etc - anything interesting you can make a mark with! *(Use whatever you have – none of it is essential)*
- Optional media: Wax crayons (water-soluble or not), white and coloured pens such as gel pens, Posca pens, felt-tip pens.
- Glue stick or PVA or Acrylic Matt Medium
- Washing up liquid
- Kitchen sponge and non-porous surface such as acetate, polythene file insert, tear-off palette sheet, freezer paper etc *(You don't need all these things, just use whatever you have to hand)*
