Exploring Acrylics: Birds & Blossoms

Wed 29th April at 10am UK time

Students will need:

- Stretched canvas / canvas board or canvas pads / acrylic paper pads / heavy watercolour paper – whatever you prefer to work on.
- Acrylic paints: Basic Colours: Process Cyan, Process Magenta, Process Yellow, (these are known as modern or cool primaries....it's also useful, but not essential to have traditional primaries – Cadmium Red & Ultramarine) plus Black & White (I would recommend Daler Rowney System 3) Feel free to use any others you may have.
- Brushes – whatever you have– I recommend a small/medium/large flat, small round brush or filbert. (Soft synthetics are good – I recommend Daler 'Graduate' range or similar) and a fine brush for detail.
- Mixing palette / plate / 'stay-wet' palette
- Kitchen roll, water pots, apron or old shirt (essential – acrylics are waterproof when dry!)
