Sketchbook Club: No Place Like Home

Starts Wed 18th February at 10am UK time

The basic requirements are very simple

- **Paper and / or sketchbook.** If you want to work with watercolour then its worth getting a sketchbook or paper that is designed for watercolour, for best results
- **Graphite pencil and / or fine liner pen**
- **Colouring materials e.g. coloured pencils and watercolour (plus a tube of white gouache)**

Any extra materials that will be used in the workshops will be listed below

Students will need:

- Week 1. Masking fluid and a dip pen (optional) or a white POSCA pen
- Week 2. Masking tape (low tack), dip pen (optional)
- Week 3. Some wrapped sweets to draw in various stages of unwrapping e.g. Quality Street
- Week 4. Kids craft foam (self-adhesive if possible – if not you will need double-sided tape) plus small pieces of card or plastic (takeaway containers are good) to back it on.
Photocopy paper, old book pages or musical scores or subtle patterned papers for collage (you will only need a small amount).
PVA glue or acrylic matt medium.
