Equipment & Materials List

Creative Paper Weaving – 2D & 3D Starts Thurs 27th November at 2pm

Students will need:

- Paper scissors, scalpel, metal ruler and cutting mat
- Tapestry needles - ideally a variety of eye sizes ranging from size 16-22 but try to get at least a size 18. Also a child's plastic needle would be useful too.
- A variety of different types of paper yarns - flat tape, twine, paper wrapped floristry wire, raffia, etc.
- A selection of printed papers - for example - photographs, magazine tears, newspapers, pages from books, wrapping paper
- A selection of plain papers in different qualities, colours and varying weights - khadi, cartridge, watercolour, etc
- Different shaped formers / moulds to weave around, with a wider top than the base.
- Double sided tape and sellotape
- Optional - soft textile yarns such as wool, cotton, etc

Suggested / Preferred Suppliers:

- Paper yarns - Sostrene Grene, Hobbii, LindeHobby, Handweavers studio, Uppingham, Paperphine
- Needles and sewing scissors- as above or Amazon
- Paper: All good art and office shops. Also look to bookbinding shops such as Shepherds of London.
